McClure is the newly appointed chief executive officer for Cabrillo Credit Union, a not-for-profit financial cooperative with five branches throughout San Diego County, with about 70 employees and \$180 million of assets.

It was founded in 1955 to serve employees of the U.S. Border Patrol, but has since expanded its charter to serve employees of other federal departments, Sharp HealthCare, the city of Carlsbad, and San Diego County residents.

McClure said Cabrillo Credit Union has worked to be a force for good in the communities it serves, lending time and support to hospital advisory councils, community events, the San Diego Salvation Army Kroc Center, and the American Heart Association.

McClure was the founding chair of San Diego's Credit Unions for Kids, a nonprofit collaboration of 16 local credit union partners who support Rady Children's Hospital through various fundraising activities. Credit Unions for Kids has raised more than \$3.1 million in cash and in-kind donations since its 1996 inception, she said.

"That program speaks volumes about credit unions. It's cooperative. We come together to raise funds for one cause, working collaboratively to support Rady Children's Hospital," said McClure, who currently serves as the local Credit Unions for Kids' chair. "People helping people' is a credit union motto and efforts like this really reflect that."

McClure joined Cabrillo Credit Union in 1992. Her executive roles over the years have included overseeing training, research compliance, marketing, human resources, and operations before her official appointment as CEO in June.

"When I think about my influence and impact on the credit union, I think of the culture of the organization and how that spills over into our community," she said. "We bring on people with a compassionate spirit to serve our members and beyond. It brings us together as a unit to serve our community."
